Composer of the Month Franz Peter Schubert

Called "the most poetic musician who ever lived," by Franz Liszt, Schubert was born in Vienna in 1797 and wrote over 1000 works in his short life. His work was popular in a small circle of admirers during his lifetime, however his popularity increased drastically almost immediately after his death.

Today, he is considered one of the best early Romantic composers and his music is frequently performed.
