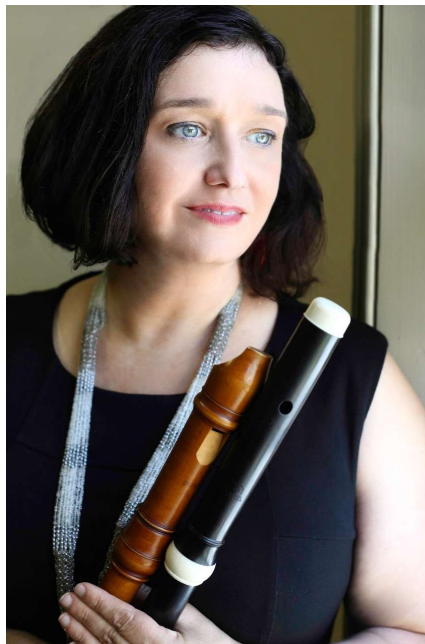




Rochester Chapter American Recorder Society's
